Glare: A discussion about what we as a community would like to experience about lighting in and near public spaces in our town. No votes, just lightly facilitated talk.

Glare from a 'strong or dazzling light' happens when the intensity of a light source against a generally dark background creates an unpleasant or annoying sensation instead of an effective visual experience. Glare defeats the purpose of night lighting. With the advent of affordable LED technology, selection of color temperature (wavelength) of light emitting diode (LED) and use of special coatings can modify the light actually reaching the eye (candelas).

Glare: We hope you will come as a concerned resident, a local expert, or member of a local business/institution to discuss how to optimally use choices available.

Glare: We will brainstorm together, then meet in small groups to share our understanding of the science behind current possibilities in outdoor lighting, and to share experiences and hopes for the future. Back together, we will compile ideas and decide on how to pursue them.
